**MORNING TIME**

Cut out a piece of paper in the shape of a heart. Write one thing you love about your child and post it on his or her mirror, door, or backpack.



**DRIVE TIME**

Ask your child, "What is a way we can show God love in this car right now?" Some ideas could be, listening to a worship song, paying for someone's meal behind you, or praying as a family. Pick an idea and do it!



**MEAL TIME**

Q&A for kids: Say the first thing that pops in your mind to finish this thought: I love \_\_\_\_\_. Why do you think that was the first thing you thought?  
Q&A for parents: What makes you feel loved?



**BED TIME**

Some people just seem harder to love than others. But we are all made by God, in His image every person matters to Him. That means that we are called to love everyone. But you don't have to do it on your own. God can give you His love, even for those people in your life who are hard to get along with. Pray that God would help you to show love to the difficult people in your life.

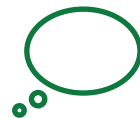
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**WEEK FIVE**

**DO THIS:**



**MORNING TIME**

If you are making your child's breakfast or lunch, grab a sharpie and pick an item that you can write the word, "forgive" on. A banana peel, bag of chips, or a granola bar. When you are saying good-bye, tell them you put a secret message in their breakfast or lunch and to be on the lookout for it!



**DRIVE TIME**

Grab a special treat through the drive through and ask your child, "Is there anyone at school, home, or church that you need to forgive or that needs forgiveness from you?" Remind them that everyone needs to be forgiven and tell them about a time you had to choose forgiveness or when someone forgave you. Forgiveness can be as sweet as the treat you are enjoying, so don't miss out—go for it!



**MEAL TIME**

Q&A for Parents: What's the biggest restoration project (e.g. room makeover, house flip, etc.) you've ever taken on?  
Q&A for Kids: What's the biggest thing someone's ever forgiven you for doing? How did you feel before and after?



**BED TIME**

God says that loving others means making the first move. Whether you need to be forgiven or whether you need to forgive, if something is wrong between you and someone else, you need to take a step to make things right. You might even say that choosing to make peace with others through forgiveness is one of the best gifts you can give God! Pray that God will help you make the first move to forgive.

**MORNING TIME**

Create a humility jar for this month and write, "put others first" on your jar as a reminder. Pick any item you would want to add; such as, pom poms, cotton balls, or M&M's. Anytime you see a family member put another family member or friend first, add one item to the jar. See if you can fill the jar by the end of the month and then celebrate with a special treat.



**DRIVE TIME**

Ask your child to help you see opportunities to let others go first while driving. Let someone ahead of you, let the next person go in the drive through, or show patience in traffic. While finding these opportunities, ask your child, "What is a way you can put someone first today?"



**MEAL TIME**

Q & A for kids: Who is a person who makes you feel important? How do they do that?  
Q & A for parents: Do you find it easier or harder to be humble as an adult than it was as a kid?



**BED TIME**

Jesus humbly gave up His life for us. But for most of us, showing humility will look different. It looks like playing with a younger sibling or allowing others to use your stuff. Share two ways you could put others first this week. Ask God to give you the power to let go of some things you think you deserve in order to put others first.
