MORNING TIME

Wrap up a special gift or treat and give it to your child. Tell them, "Use this gift as a reminder that Jesus is the greatest gift of all."



DRIVE TIME

While driving around, have your child look out the window and talk about the things you see here on Earth and what they will be like in heaven. For example, you see a flower and you can say you think the flower will be even bigger or brighter in Heaven. Heaven will have an ocean that is crystal clear and the most beautiful blue.



MEAL TIME

Q & A for kids: Why do you think we give gifts?
Q & A for parents: What was the best gift you ever received as a child?



BED TIME

Share about a situation in your life that's difficult right now. When Paul faced tough times, he chose to see them as opportunities. He knew that Jesus can use even the hardest moments for good. It's okay to be sad about the difficult things you face, but you can ask God to change your perspective. Pray for each other, that God will work in and through your difficult times this week.

DAILY CUES



Morning Time

On your child's mirror, write a few quality characteristics you see in them. (kind, funny, grateful, strong, brave, wise) At the bottom of the mirror, write, "God created you for a purpose." This will be a great reminder to them as they start their day!



Drive Time

While in the car, ask your child to look around outside and take turns finishing this sentence, "God is so creative, He created . . ." Then, talk about your favorite creation and why.



Meal Time

Q & A FOR KIDS: How do you think God made you creative?

Q&A FOR PARENTS: Who is someone you see use their creativity for God's Glory?



Bed Time

Read the story about Esther. As a family discuss this question, "What is something that excites you or gives you energy?" God has a purpose for us and sometimes that might seem really hard to figure out. Pay attention to the moments you get excited about ideas or service projects and realize that might be part of what His purpose is for you. Talk about how you can help each other grow in the areas you discussed and pray for God's clarity on His purpose for you.

Plan a time when you will be close to a friend's house and drop something special off for them! You can write a card or make a special treat. This is a great way to show you care.



Meal Time

Q & A FOR KIDS: Who is your best friend? Why do you think you're such good friends?

Q&A FOR PARENTS: Who was your best friend when you were little? How did you meet them? Are you still friends?



Bed Time

Take a few minutes to share how you have been encouraged by someone else. Now, brainstorm some ways that you could encourage a friend this week. It might be drawing a card, taking an extra treat in your lunch to share, or just giving them a big smile. Pray that God would show you creative ways to encourage your friends this week.
