



WEEK ONE

LUKE 22:54-62;
JOHN 21:15-19;
EPHESIANS 2:8-9

Jesus still loves Peter, even though Peter denies even knowing Jesus when he is asked about Him.

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WEEK TWO

ACTS 17:16-34

Paul tells the people in Athens about the God who made everything, and how He gave us His Son, Jesus.

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WEEK THREE

ACTS 28:11-31

Paul tells the people in Rome that they can believe everything Jesus says because Jesus tells the truth.

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WEEK FOUR

JOHN 14:2-3; ACTS 1:1-11

Jesus tells His disciples that He is going away to prepare a place for everyone who believes in Him.

DO THIS:



MORNING TIME

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning! I see some (color) hair. I see some (color) eyes. I see a cute nose. I see a beautiful smile. I see a ticklish tummy (give a little tickle). I see someone Jesus loves, and He wants to be [his/her] friend forever. Who could it be? (Smile.) Yes! Jesus loves YOU and wants to be YOUR friend forever!"



DRIVE TIME

Give your child a clipboard, paper, and washable crayons as you get in the car. Tell them to draw something God made while you drive. When you get where you are going, ask your child to show you their drawing and tell you about it. When you get home, put it on the fridge as a reminder that God made the whole world and everything in it.



CUDDLE TIME

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, I ask that You help [child's name] value truth. I ask that you help [him/her] believe that Jesus is always telling the truth, and that means we can always trust what He says. Thank You for sending Jesus to be our friend forever. You are the best, God, and we love You very much. In Jesus' name, amen."



BATH TIME

Add plastic building blocks to bath time this month. Encourage your child to build whatever they like. Say, "Jesus went away to build a special place so everyone who believes in Him can live with Him forever. This special place is called Heaven."

DAILY CUES



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "God made the sun and sky so blue. God made me, and God made you!" Tickle your child when you say, "you."



Drive Time

As you drive, challenge your child to try and count the number of hairs on their head. When they give up or give you a random number, say, "Guess what! God knows exactly how many hairs are on your head! One, God knows everything. And two, you are SO important to God that He even thinks about how many hairs are on your head. I think that is pretty amazing!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for loving us SO much that You sent Your Son, Jesus, to be our friend forever. We love You, God. In Jesus' name, amen."



Bath Time

Add toy plates, utensils, and food to bathtime so your child can pretend to cook breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Talk about how we can talk to God during breakfast time, lunch time, and dinner time. We can even talk to God during playtime, bedtime, and bath time! We can talk to God anytime, anywhere, about anything!

Pharaoh puts Joseph in charge of saving grain after Joseph helps him understand his dreams.

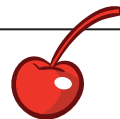
Week Four

DAILY CUES



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, say, "Good morning, (name of child)! God has good things planned for us to do today!"



Drive Time

As you drive or take a walk, say to your child, "Do you remember how Joseph was a helper in the Bible story? Let's take turns saying different things we can do to help others."



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child this month and pray, "Dear God, thank You for planning good things for us to do. Help us to look for the good, even when bad things are happening. You always have something good planned for us to do! We love You, God. In Jesus' name. Amen."



Bath Time

Add plastic water and land animals to bath time. Talk about God's plan for each animal. Some were made to swim in water (bath water) and others were made to walk on land (side of tub). Tell your child to sort the animals by water and land. Talk about how God loves people the best, and He has a plan for us too!
